The **27th Australian Colloid & Surface Science Student Conference** will be held at the **Roseworthy Campus of the University of Adelaide**. Staff and students will be accommodated in the student residences.

The Conference Format

Preference for oral presentations will be given to students in their second and third year.

Hunter-Healy Award

The Hunter-Healy Award honours the founders of the Australian Colloid and Surface Science Student Conference; Professor Tom Healy (The University of Melbourne) and Professor Bob Hunter (University of Sydney), who first organised this conference in 1967.



The conferences have been held regularly since this time. The Award, which highlights and recognises the most outstanding student oral presentation at the conference, consists of a commemorative medal and a contribution towards the travel costs of attending an international conference. The Award is founded by Royal Australian Chemical Institute (RACI). Students enrolled at an Australian university are eligible candidates for this award.
