**Hilda Zhang v The Royal Australian Chemical Institute Inc (M76, M77, M129 and M130/2005)**

**Notices of a constitutional matter under s 78B of the *Judiciary Act 1903***

We refer to your previous emails to the Attorney-General for Victoria and to your email to Mr Bracey, Electorate Officer for Mr Mildenhall.

This office deals with all s 78B notices referred to the Attorney-General for the State of Victoria.

The s 78B notices which were sent to the Attorney-General in this matter referred to special leave applications. As a general rule, the Attorney-General does not intervene in special leave applications. The High Court has indicated previously that it is not appropriate as, until leave is granted, there is nothing to intervene in.

As the High Court refused special leave, there is no further role for the Attorney-General in this matter.
